IN THE MATTER OF: DENISE F. HEMMANN

Atlanta, July 13, 2010 – Last week, the Supreme Court of Georgia issued an opinion disbarring Denise Hemmann from practicing law in Georgia. The Court now wishes to correct the record: Ms. Hemmann has not been disbarred.

Yesterday, on July 12, the state Supreme Court unanimously vacated its July 5, 2010 opinion. In the new opinion, the high court rejects the discipline recommended by the State Bar of Georgia. The reason, the new opinion states, is that the Notice of Discipline “contains conflicting recommendations as to the discipline the State requested this Court to impose.” The matter now returns to the State Bar to correct its conflicting recommendations.
